Attention senior families- The FAFSA has undergone many changes including the opening date being pushed back to December. To help navigate the FAFSA process, NCMC Financial Aid representatives will be onsite for a FAFSA Completion Night on February 7th from 5:30-7:00 at Linn County school in Room 8. In order to submit your student's FAFSA that night you MUST complete the following steps:

- 1. FSA ID for student and contributor set up at least 72 hours prior to February 7th.
- 2. Bring all contributors' 2022 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned
- 3. Bring all asset information including value of cash, savings, checking and records of net worth investments and any net worth of business/farms
- 4. Bring amount of child support received in past year (if applicable)
- 5. Bring list of any federal benefits received



I plan to attend North Central Missouri College and graduate with an Associates of Arts Degree and then transfer to a university and finish out my major in Illustration/Directorship.


