Welcome to the 2017 Meadville Invitational Basketball Tournament to be held January 23 through January 28 at Meadville R-IV High School.

Please make sure your team is here at a reasonable time so if the tournament runs ahead of time we can stay ahead of schedule.

Please Note the following Items:

**(TOP TEAM ON BRACKET WILL BE HOME TEAM)**

1. Have your pass list and roster sent to me by Friday, January 13<sup>th</sup>. Only one person per line on the pass list.
2. Admission: Adults: \$3.00 Senior Citizens & Students: \$2.00 **NO PASSES ACCEPTED**
3. **ONLY** players are to be on the gym floor. All spectators are to walk outside the floor boundaries when entering and exiting the gym.
4. **Buses are to load and unload on the South side of school and will park there also.**
5. Pass gate will be inside the double doors along with the general admission gate at the South end only. **People on the pass list are to enter here only.**
6. Home team (wear light) sits on the North side of the scorers' table and visitors (wear dark) sit on the South side. Cheerleaders will be on their corresponding team's end.
7. Teams are not to warm up on the game floor during the half time of the current game
8. Locker rooms will be assigned when each team arrives.
9. There will be a hospitality room in the building for administrators, coaches, officials, tournament workers, and bus drivers. Children will not be allowed to stay in the hospitality room.
10. Drums, musical instruments, and mechanical noisemakers are prohibited.
11. Concessions will be available in the cafeteria for the convenience of all spectators and participants. Bottled drinks, popcorn, and candy allowed in gym.
12. Sportsmanship is considered an essential part of athletic competition. Let us all stress this for our teams and fans.
13. Meadville R-IV School District prohibits the use of all tobacco products on or within in the school grounds. This policy applies to all employees, students, and parents attending school-sponsored activities and/or meetings. The Administration and School Board thank you for your cooperation in creating a safe and healthy educational environment. (Policy 5250,2640)
