Elementary -AMI (Alternative Method of Instruction) Day

The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education requires the School District to take attendance on AMI Days. Students will be counted absent if they do not log on during the AMI scheduled times. The student(s) will be held accountable for any work assigned on AMI days and they will have consequences for not completing the work that is assigned.

PreK, K, 1st and 2nd grades will not bring chromebooks home. These students will each have packets that are labeled snow day #1, snow day #2, etc. On snow day #1 please have your child(ren) complete the packet that states snow day #1. The student will then return that work to the teacher on the next day they are in attendance. If we have 2 snow days in a row, have them complete the snow day #2 packet on the second snow day and also return that work to the teacher on the next day they are in attendance. Please leave the other packets labeled snow days #3, #4, etc. in their folders to complete if we would have to have other snow days at a different time.

3-5—Google meet live sessions. If recorded, sessions will be linked to Google classroom. Each elementary teacher will create their own schedule. Instruction will begin no earlier than 9 am and end no later than noon. Specials teachers record lesson/activity and put on Google classroom (not for PREK, K or 1st). Elementary teachers will give the students time to access specials from 11:34-11:54 am. Sessions will be live. Teachers will have lunch from 12:00 – 12:30 pm.
